DRUM CORPS UNITED KINGDOM Information

Drum Corps United Kingdom (DCUK) is a charitable organisation registered with The Charity Commissioners and run BY the members FOR the members. The organisation runs events during the summer and early autumn months. DCUK elects a Board annually to run the activity. Three of these board members also stand as trustees and serve on the board of our governing charity - Marching & Performing Arts UK (MPA:UK).

Competitive Classes

In 2019 DCUK will organise and run four regional Drum Corps competitions plus the 38^{th} British Drum Corps Championships.

There are three competitive classes;

- Open Class
- A Class (Championships only)
- Junior Class
- Plus SoundSport & DrumLine Battle

The Open & A Classes are divisional classes based primarily on performance standard with no age restrictions.

The Junior Class is open to new/inexperienced units or Cadet Corps with the emphasis on performance and enjoyment rather than competition.

All styles of marching units will be warmly welcomed to perform an exhibition at any of our Regional shows.

There are no qualifying criteria for the DCUK Championships – however Corps do need to compete in at least one DCUK event to be eligible for the Drum Corps Europe Championships.

Corps are able to compete using any form of instrumentation.

HOW DO YOU PARTICIPATE?

Simply prepare a 1.5 to 2.0 minute marching percussion drum solo (battery only). Add some visuals, stunts and stick tricks and you're good to go! It's that easy and it's a lot of fun. You can use material from your winter line, fall show or something produced just for this event.

- Battles are staged head-to-head against another drumline.
- Each team will perform a 1.5 to 2.0 minute solo facing the other team in their own 12 meter x 12 meter battle zone, separated by a 2 meter wide neutral zone.
- Judges will instantly determine the winning team, based on a combination of drumming skills, movement, visuals, stick tricks, stunts and overall showmanship.

Membership Requirement

Membership of DCUK is open to all British Drum and Bugle Corps (and Corps style units) as defined in the rules of the organisation. Interested potential members should initially contact the DCUK Board for an information pack and application form.

On receipt of their application, Corps will be contacted by the local member of the DCUK Board who will arrange to visit or have an informal chat, to answer any questions and to offer advice. There is no audition or "standards" qualification for membership although we may wish to visit you if you are a "main" Corps and decide to enter the Junior Class.

None member units are actively encouraged to exhibit (and be judged if required) at any DCUK Regional contest – contact us for details.


